PreK/Elementary Programming

Program	Activity	Description
Early Firefighting/Bucket Brigade 1 hour to 1 hour 15 minutes COST: \$10 PER STUDENT	Lesson: Early Firefighting (20 minutes) Choose one or do both! Activity 1: (20-25 minutes) Bucket Brigade - As a team, fill the empty bucket with ping pong balls, in a bucket brigade style. Activity 2: (20-25 minutes) Decorate your own bucket!	Children will learn the history of early firefighting and experience how colonial citizens fought fires by forming bucket brigades.
911-- What to Know & When to Call 1 hour to 1 hour 15 minutes COST: \$10 PER STUDENT	In-class activity: (10 minutes) Storytime about firefighters to learn about what they look like and how they sound. (30 minutes) Group discussion with Yes/No Paddles learning about emergency vs. non-emergency situations. (10 minutes) Practice calling 911 on a pretend cell phone and ways to quickly access 911 on a phone. (20 minutes) Finish with a cut and paste activity to reinforce what we learned. Take-home activity: Packet of papers including a worksheet for a guardian to help fill out with the child's important information to hang on the fridge in case of a child calling 911.	Children will learn how to understand the difference between an emergency and a non emergency. Learn skills on how to dial 911 and what to know when you dial 911.

PreK/Elementary Programming

Program	Activity	Description
Stop, Drop, and Roll Storytime and Practice 1 hour COST: \$10 PER STUDENT	Lesson: (30 minutes) Story time about SDR and lesson including picture cards; teaching children how to identify what's hot/not and situations that could lead to needing SDR. In-class activity: (30 minutes) Get to roll across and practice SDR skills with our SDR staging mat! Also decorate a SDR headband!	Children will learn the importance of why we Stop, Drop, and Roll in case our clothes or hair catch on fire. Important!! Need space for the SDR staging mat (10 feet by 4 feet)!
Dalmatian History 45 minutes to an hour COST: \$15 PER STUDENT	Lesson: Story time about Sparkles the Fire Dog and real-life pictures of Dalmatians at work. In-class activity: Receive a plush Dalmatian and decorate your own tag! (20 minutes) and Get your picture made with Sparkles the Dalmatian! (10 minutes-life-size Dalmatian plush)	Children will learn about the Firefighter's special sidekick, the Dalmatian!

Program	Activity	Description
September 11th Memorial Program 45 minutes to an hour COST: \$10 PER PERSON	After a presentation, video, and talk-back, we will write Thank you Cards to local first-responders that I will deliver after the program. NEED ACCESS TO LARGER SCREEN FOR VIDEO!	A 9/11 tribute program to honor those who served in NYC from Haverhill on that tragic day 24 years ago and provide space for individuals to recall memories and give thanks to current first-responders.
Colonial Firefighting/Bucket Brigade 45 minutes to an hour COST: \$10 PER PERSON	Lesson: Early Firefighting (20 minutes) Choose one or do both! Activity 1: (20-25 minutes) Bucket Brigade - As a team, fill the empty bucket with ping pong balls, in a bucket brigade style. Activity 2: (20-25 minutes) Decorate your own bucket!	Adults will learn the history of early firefighting and experience how colonial citizens fought fires by forming bucket brigades.
